

Ireka secures RM36m building job

IREKA Corp Bhd said its construction unit, Ireka Engineering & Construction Sdn Bhd, has bagged a RM36.2 million infrastructure project from the Iskandar Regional Development Authority (IRDA).

The contract is to build the proposed Bandar Indahpura, Kulai-Second Link Expressway Interchange in Iskandar Malaysia, Johor.

Ireka told Bursa Malaysia yesterday it will undertake the construction of bridges and vehicular box culverts, drainage works, pavement works, as well as street lighting, retaining walls and electrical works.

As at end-March 2010, the group's total construction order book stood at RM1 billion, Ireka Corp group managing director, Lai Siew Wah said.
